

The Hanover Area Arts Guild's 2016 Spring Show for Members

Rules and Information

1. Only new work not previously displayed in our gallery will be accepted for this show.
2. HAAG members may enter up to four (4) pieces for display and judging. There is no entry fee.
3. All work must be for sale. Work priced "NFS" or "Not for Sale" will not be accepted.
4. All work must follow the gallery's standard size guidelines: Framed work - no more than 45" in height or width, measured from the outside of the frame. Three-dimensional work – no more than 45" in any dimension (height, width, and depth).
5. All two-dimensional work (paintings, drawings, photos, etc.) must be properly framed and wired for hanging. Work with saw-tooth and other non-wire hangers are not acceptable and will not be displayed in the exhibit.
6. Your entries will be placed in one of the following categories for judging:
 - Oil and Acrylic Paintings (paintings in these media on canvas, panels, or other prepared surfaces)
 - Watercolor (watercolor paintings on paper or Yupo)
 - Other Media (pencil drawing, colored pencil, pastel, ink drawing, printmaking, encaustic, mixed media, fiber arts)
 - Photography/Digital Art (traditional photography in black & white or color, digitally enhanced photography, digitally produced art and illustration)
 - Three-Dimensional (sculpture in any media, three-dimensional crafts, jewelry)
 - Youth Members (Current youth members of the Arts Guild may submit up to four entries in any media. The rules, as printed above, must be followed for framing and size restrictions. Student work may be marked "Not for Sale" if preferred.)

Deliver entries to the gallery on Friday, March 25th (10:00-7:00) or Saturday, March 26th (10:00-3:00).

Upon delivery, be prepared to:

- Enter your information in the gallery inventory book on the front counter.
- Print a gallery tag for each entry, and attach it to hang from the bottom right of framed work, and to an appropriate place on other entries. Tags are available at the front counter.
- Place your entries in the area designated for each category. Signs will be placed on the walls for this purpose.

The opening reception will be held Friday, April 1st, from 6:00-8:00. Awards will be presented at 7:00. Winners will be notified before the reception. Please plan to attend!

The Spring Show will be on display throughout April during regular gallery hours. The show will close on Saturday, April 30.

Please do not remove work before Friday, April 29th (10:00-7:00), or Saturday, April 30th (10:00-3:00). Any works that are sold during the exhibit may be removed by the purchaser at the time of sale.

The judge for the 2016 Spring Show is Jeff Barnhart. Jeff is a graduate of the Ringling School of Art & Design in Sarasota, FL. He resides in Chambersburg, PA, and is a member of the Franklin County Art Alliance. He is well-known in Chambersburg and the surrounding region as an artist and instructor. Jeff works both in his studio and *en plein-air*. His work, most often produced in oils, pastel, or watercolor, is often inspired by his travels around the world.
