Throughout the rest of the year, the Gallery displays will be all about members. Beginning with the second week of October, member work will be exhibited in both gallery rooms. Annual Fall Show in November

Active members will find enclosed with this newsletter the information and entry form for the Fall Show. Please be sure to read the instructions and rules carefully, to avoid delay or disappointment when you bring work for this show. Key highlights:

- Submit up to four works. You can designate up to two pieces for judging.
- All work must be for sale.
- All work must be new (within the past three years), and not previously shown in our gallery.
- Work to be hung must be properly prepared for hanging.
- Attach completed tags to each entry.
- Complete registration form and bring it, with your entries and entry fee (\$15 for adult members, \$5 for youth members).
- Deliver work Thursday thru Saturday, October 26-28 during regular Gallery hours, only.

Remember, your Arts Guild membership must be current to enter. If you have not already renewed your membership, please be prepared to do so when you deliver work.

The Gallery Committee will meet on October 31 to hang the show. Awards judge **Nancy Mendes** will make her selections soon thereafter.

The show **reception** is set for Sunday, November 5, from 2-4pm. Awards will be presented at 3pm. This reception is always a great opportunity to meet and mingle with fellow members and guests, enjoy refreshments, and see a wonderful array of art created by colleagues and friends.

Artist of the Month
