Art Downtown Class Instruction Information & Application

Thank you for your interest to instruct at Art Downtown! We strive to offer the community various avenues for art appreciation, and our instructors play a large part in reaching that goal. As a professional organization, we expect instructors to relay their methods and techniques professionally, and to follow Guild rules and requirements at all times.

SEASONS

The Guild offers classes to the public during the four seasons, which run as:

Winter Class Schedule – December, January, February Spring Class Schedule – March, April, May Summer Class Schedule – June, July, August Fall Class Schedule – September, October, November

CLASS/WORKSHOP LENGTH

Courses can run as one-day workshops, or multiple week classes. This is completely up to the instructor and depends on the amount of time needed for the skills/class level.

PAYMENT

Instructors with Guild membership receive 70% of the class/workshop fee, and non-Guild members receive 60%. Payments are made to the Hanover Area Arts Guild. Instructors will be paid when all students have paid in full. The instructor is responsible for making sure participants pay and to notify the Guild when they are ready to be paid. Instructors may add a fee for materials provided which would be collected by the instructor, or hand out a supply list to each student to purchase their own supplies.

REQUIRED CLEARANCES

If your class is geared toward or open to persons under 18, you will need to have Child Abuse and Criminal History clearances from the state in order to instruct. For liability reasons, there's no exception to this. These clearances are not necessary for adult-only classes.
