Awards Judge

- Forms may be mailed or hand-delivered.

Eligibility

- Open to all artists age 18 and older.
- Work must be original and completed within the last two years.
- Reproductions of work and other copies will not be accepted.
- Work shown in any previous Arts Guild Open Exhibit will not be accepted.

Awards

- Best of Show - \$200
- \$1200 in additional awards.
- Winning artists will be notified by email prior to the reception date.

Sales Agreement

Artists are encouraged, but not required, to offer entries for sale. All sales will be handled by the Hanover Area Arts Guild. The Arts Guild retains 30% on items priced \$100 and up, and 20% on items priced below \$100. Sales checks will be mailed to artists within 30 days of the close of the exhibit. **Work that is not for sale must be marked "NFS" on the entry forms, along with the fair-market dollar value of the item for insurance purposes.** Entering this show indicates agreement with all of the terms set forth in this prospectus.

Requirements – Please Read!

Complete the entry form and mail or deliver, with the entry fee, to the Hanover Area Arts Guild, 32 Carlisle Street, Hanover, PA 17331. **Entry forms must be received no later than 3:00 pm, Saturday March 16, 2019.**

Art must be hand-delivered to the gallery on one of the dates listed on this form. No exceptions, please!

2-D art must be properly framed. Paintings and photos on stretched canvases may be unframed only if they have finished edges. All pictures must be adequately wired to hang. Other types of non-wire hangers will not be accepted.

Oil and acrylic paintings must be dry. Watercolors, drawing media, pastels, and photographs must be properly framed and protected under glass or Plexiglas.

The maximum allowable size for all work, including 3-D, is 32 inches in any direction. Framed work is measured from the outside of the frame. Art should be appropriate for viewing by all ages. The Arts Guild reserves the right to reject work that does not meet the standards.

Categories for Judging

1. Oil and Acrylic Paintings
2. Watercolor Paintings
3. Other Media – (all drawing media, pastels, collage, mixed media, printmaking, fiber arts, and others as determined by the gallery hanging committee.)
4. Three-Dimensional Art (includes sculpture, ceramics, jewelry, and fine art crafts)
5. Photography and Digital Arts

Artists must indicate the category of each entry (using the numbers listed above) on the entry form and tags.
