

Using Colored Pencils on Black Paper

- Small drawing board, even a 9" x 12" piece of foam core or corrugated cardboard will do
- Masking tape
- Scissors
- Scotch tape
- Ball point pen or any bright-colored Prismacolor Verithin pencil
- Removable mounting putty
- Kneaded eraser
- White plastic eraser
- Narrow diameter white plastic eraser in a pen-type holder, such as General's Factis BM2 or Tombow's Mono Zero, very useful but **optional**
- Staedtler Black Edition or Faber-Castell Dust-Free Eraser - **optional**
- Drafting or other soft brush for removing eraser crumbs
- Handheld, battery-powered or electric pencil sharpener that will give a VERY sharp point
- Prismacolor Premier pencils (**not Scholar**)
 - White PC938 (you will need AT LEAST 2)
 - Canary Yellow PC916
 - Pale Vermilion PC921 or Pumpkin Orange PC1032
 - Carmine Red PC926
 - Poppy Red PC922
 - Apple Green PC912
 - Spring Green PC913
 - Terra Cotta PC944
 - Tuscan Red PC937
- **NOTE: due to the relatively transparent nature of colored pencil, only Prismacolor Premier pencils are recommended for this class as they are the most opaque brand. In particular, the Prismacolor Premier White pencil is essential to producing quality results for this technique.**
