Delivery of Entry Forms and Art to the Gallery: Bring your entries to the gallery on Friday, Oct. 28 (12-4) or Saturday, Oct. 29 (12-4). Deliver your art, entry form and fee at the same time. Fees can be paid at the desk by cash, check, or credit card. Make sure your art is ready to hang or display when it is delivered.

Entry Fees: Adult and College Student Artists - \$25 for up to 3 pieces. (Students in grades K-12: there is no entry fee. Students may enter up to 3 pieces.) You do not have to pre-register to enter this show; just bring the entry form and fee to the gallery when you deliver entries.

Eligibility: You must be a current member of the Hanover Area Arts Guild. Dues must be paid in full. Dues can be paid when you deliver your Fall Show entries.

READ THIS INFORMATION BEFORE ENTERING THE FALL SHOW

1. **All art must be for sale.** "NFS" or "Not for Sale" items will not be included in this show. The Guild retains 30% of the sale of items priced \$100 or over, and 20% of items priced under \$100. K-12 student work does not have to be for sale.
2. **You may enter up to three (3) pieces.** All entries will be judged. Artists may request not to be judged.
3. **All entries must have been completed within the past two (2) years and not previously shown in the Arts Guild's gallery.**
4. **Size limits: Entries may not exceed 48 inches in any dimension.** For hanging work, this is measured from the outside of the frame. Three-dimensional work may not exceed 48 inches in height, width, or depth, and must be easily moved by one person.
5. **Hanging work must be properly framed. (Grades K-12: See instructions on the next page).** Watercolors, drawings, pastels, photographs, and other media on paper must be framed under glass or Plexiglas. Paintings on unframed stretched canvas must have neatly painted side edges. Paintings must be completely dry. Frames and mats must be in good condition. All hanging work must be prepared for display with picture wire. Any other type of hanging device will not be accepted. The Guild reserves the right to reject any work that does not meet these requirements. The Guild will not be responsible for any damage caused by improper preparation of artwork.
6. **All work must meet the Guild's standards of originality.** Copies of work by other artists or from copyrighted images are unacceptable. Reproduction prints of paintings or drawings will not be accepted in this show; it must be the original piece. Subject matter must be appropriate for viewing by all age groups. The Guild reserves the right to reject any work that does not meet these standards.
7. **Entries made from commercially designed and manufactured parts without significant alteration by the artist or craftsman will not be accepted.** For example, decorated candles, items cast in molds not made by the artist, or any art made from commercial kits may not be entered.
8. **Entries cannot be removed before November 26.** Artwork may remain in the gallery until December 31 if the artist chooses to leave it on display.

Kristin Kest - Fall Show Awards Judge

Kristen Kest is an accomplished painter, illustrator, and ceramic artist. She earned her undergraduate degree from York College and an MFA from Maryland Institute College of Art (MICA). She taught illustration and drawing courses at York College for nine years and has taught community classes in hand-built ceramics. Kristen is known for her botanical illustration work and product design; you can see her illustrations on the covers of The Old Farmer's Almanac garden calendars. She describes her ceramic work as an offshoot of her illustration work. Kristen also creates fine art paintings that are based on figural and feminist themes. Note to All Artists: Art will not be separated into media categories for the Fall Show. Entries will be judged on artistic merits, including picture composition, use of artistic elements, and mastery of medium.

Note to College Students – Entries will be shown and judged with adult member art. Art must be prepared for display as described on the previous page.

Instructions for Students in Grades K-12:

- Picture frames are optional for paintings and drawings.
- If work is in a picture frame, wire must be properly attached across the back for hanging. Other types of picture hanging hardware cannot be used.
- Unframed art on paper must be neatly matted. A cardboard or foam-core board backing is recommended for sturdiness.
- Paintings on canvas panels do not have to be framed or wired.
- Paintings on canvas stretched on wooden bars: all side edges must be neatly painted, and wire must be attached across the back with screw eyes.
- K-12 student work does not have to be for sale.
